Indiana Central College can be reached from Interstate Highway 465. At the interchange of Interstate 465 and Highway 31 turn north on 31 to the second stoplight (Hanna Avenue). Turn east on Hanna Avenue and follow it for four blocks to the college. The Fine Arts Building is on the south side of Hanna Avenue. Parking facilities are available behind the Fine Arts Building, north of Academic Hall, or on the north side of the campus.

For those who wish to come through the city, the college can be reached by taking the Madison Avenue Expressway south until the intersection with Hanna Avenue or taking the expressway onto Highway 431 until it intersects with Hanna Avenue. The college is a few blocks east of either intersection.
