#### **Driving Directions to IU**

Take route 37 toward Bloomington and get off 37 at the 45/46 bypass, going east. At the second stop light, which is College Avenue, turn right or south. Drive south until you get to 7th Street -- it is over a mile from the bypass -- then turn left or east. Continue on 7th until you see the entrance to the Memorial Union on your right, marked by a "toll booth" in the center of the street. The Union is hard to miss; it is a vast limestone structure on your right, extending for over a block. The automobile entrance is at the east end of the Union, just east of the intersection of 7th Street with Woodlawn. There is a pay parking lot on your right (if there is a person in the toll booth to take your money.)

#### **Directions to the Maple Room**

The Maple Room is on the mezzanine floor of the Union. To find it, enter the Union through the revolving doors that face the parking lot. You can take the stairs (or the elevators) up one floor from the hotel lobby, which is just inside the revolving doors. On the mezzanine floor, turn left through the lounge and then left along the long corridor. When you get to the area with wall-to-wall carpeting (which is the suite of conference rooms) turn right. The Maple Room is the second room on the left.
